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1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The presented program for the development of pole sport in Ukraine for 2022-2027, (hereinafter referred to as - "Development program") was developed by the Republican Public Association "Ukrainian Pole Sport and Aerial Acrobatics Federation").

The program is developed on the basis of methodological approaches to the administration of state and regional policies in the field of physical culture and sports and is aimed at solving primary objectives of the development of pole sport in the Ukraine.

Purposes of the program:

- To unite all people engaged in gymnastics, acrobatics, balancing, choreography, and acting skills demonstrated by performing competitive programs on aerial silks/fabrics, freestanding as well as permanently fixed poles into the single community – pole sport, for purposes of joint training, discussion and development of this direction of sports in all cities of Ukraine, neighboring countries and beyond.
- Assistance to the state in ensuring the rights of citizens of the Ukraine of all ages and social groups, primarily children, adolescents and youth, to meet their needs in pole sport in the Ukraine and to participate in sports events.
- Establishment of the necessary material and technical, scientific, and methodological, organizational, and other conditions for the effective training of athletes – members of the national team of Ukraine and their reserves in pole sport for official national and international competitions.
- Participation in the implementation of the strategy for the development of physical culture and sports in Ukraine and assistance to regional legislative and executive authorities;
- Consolidation of material and technical, financial, organizational, human, and information resources for solving the objectives set.

Objectives of the program:

- ensuring the implementation of a comprehensive program of training of Ukraine athletes for national competitions with the purpose to get into the national team of Ukraine and further participate in international competitions;
- establishment of material and technical foundation in Kharkov and other regions;
- assistance in reconstruction and construction of new sports facilities for pole sport in Kharkov and other regions;

- defining the role and place of the Federation in the implementation of state and regional development programs, bringing the Federation's activities in line with the law on physical culture and sports;
- assistance in the development of pole sport as a national sport at the state level;
- strengthening the Federation's activities in obtaining funds from the Central Government budget and regional budgets, as well as from extra-budgetary resources;
- improvement of the judging system;
- assistance in improving the social protection of specialists working in sports organizations, coaches and athletes, teachers, scientists, judges, volunteers and social workers;
- organization and hosting of sporting and mass participation events;
- conducting official regional, national, and international events;
- implementation of measures for the development of sports for children and young people;
- improvement of the forms of interaction with the media;
- implementation of the rights and obligations arising from the legislative and regulatory framework in the field of physical culture and sports and improvement of own regulatory environment.

Terms and stages of the program implementation:

Stage 1 – years 2024 to 2025:

- development and formation of the framework arrangements for management and interaction;
- establishment of material and technical foundation in Kharkov and regions;
- assistance in reconstruction and construction of new sports facilities for pole sport in Kharkov and other regions;
- ensuring the implementation of a comprehensive program of training of Ukrainian athletes for national competitions with the purpose to get into the national team of Ukraine and further participate in international competitions;
- assistance in the development and implementation of programs aimed at modernizing pole sport for children and young people as well as modernizing the system of selection and training of sports reserves;
- assistance in improving the scientific and methodological foundations of the pole sport;
- development of a strategy to improve the status of pole sport in Ukraine conforming to the world status;
- organization and implementation of promotion of the pole sport with the involvement of mass media;

Stage 2 – years 2025 to 2026:

- implementation of a comprehensive program of training of Ukrainian athletes for national competitions with the purpose to get into the national team of Ukraine and further participate in international competitions;
- reconstruction and construction of new sports facilities for pole sport in Kharkov and other regions;
- monitoring the legislative and regulatory framework;
- modernizing the programs that are necessary for the expansion of functional relations and authority;
- improvement of the organizational framework for management and interaction;
- improvement of the methods for solving the main objectives of the first stage;
- preparation of a draft Program for the development of Ukrainian's sport such as pole sport for years 2024 – 2037;
- promotion of pole sport with the involvement of the media.

Expected end results of the program implementation:

- establishment of material and technical foundation in Kharkov and regions;
- increase in the number of people engaged in the pole sport in Kharkov and other regions, especially in groups of children and youth;
- attracting young professionals for engaging in coaching activities;
- development of sports for children and young people.

Responsible for the implementation of the program:

Ukrainian Pole Sport and Aerial Acrobatics Federation, Agency of the Ukraine for sports and physical culture.

Amounts and sources of funding for the program:

Agency of the Ukraine for sports and physical culture, Ukrainian Pole Sport and Aerial Acrobatics Federation, Kharkov city, extra-budgetary funding.

Program implementation monitoring system:

Agency of the Ukraine for sports and physical culture.

3. MAIN DIRECTIONS OF THE PROGRAM

1) the first and main direction of the program at this stage is the development of pole sport

a) High performance sport

The purpose of this section of the Program is to create conditions for the successful training of Ukrainian athletes for national competitions with the purpose to get into the national team of Ukraine and further participate in international competitions;

Main objectives:

- development and implementation of training programs for athletes;
- development of the national development program;
- creation of the National team training center in Ukraine;
- development of the material and technical foundation for pole sport;
- improving the level of scientific and methodological and medical and biological support for athletes;
- improvement of the calendar of sports events and the selection system for the national team of Ukraine;
- improving the quality of training and retraining of coaches and other specialists of national teams of Ukraine;
- improvement of the legislative and regulatory framework for high performance sports;
- improving the mechanism for managing sports, organizing, and conducting sports events.

b) Training of sports reserves

The central section of the program is aimed at creating the conditions for the selection and training of gifted children, adolescents, and youth for the national teams of Ukraine.

Main objectives:

- improving the calendar of sports events, introducing a scientifically based system of sports orientation and evaluating the prospects of young athletes into the practice of training athletes;

- creating a system of scientific and methodological support for sports training and medical control;
- improving the regulatory framework of the sports reserve;
- promoting the creation of favorable conditions for the effective operation of the pole sport departments;
- improving the quality of training and retraining of coaches and teachers;

2) Physical education of schoolchildren, students and trainees.

Development and improvement of the system of physical education for children and young students is a priority for state and public organizations in the country.

The purpose of this section of the program is to develop a set of measures to ensure the development and improvement of the operation of the physical education system for students on the basis of pole sport.

Main objectives:

- participation in the development of the legal fundamentals and regulatory framework for the development of the system of physical education of students and trainees;
- development of national regulations for the level of physical fitness of students;
- development of a system of educational and methodological support for sports training in specialized educational facilities and academic institutions;
- assistance in expanding the material and technical foundation in educational facilities and academic institutions for sports;
- improving the quality of training, retraining and advanced training of personnel;
- organization of development and operation of the information provision system;
- assistance in improving the system of medical and pedagogical supervision;
- creating a database and provision of monitoring of the physical development and fitness level of gifted, promising young athletes.

3) Pole sport mass movement

The purpose of sports and recreation activities in the community is to attract young people to engage in pole sport in organized forms.

Main objectives:

- establishment of dance schools, pole sport clubs;
- improvement of target training, retraining and advanced training of specialists for working in pole sport clubs;
- development of an effective system for promoting a healthy lifestyle for the population;
- creating a system of sporting and mass participation events.

4) Medical support

The purpose of this section of the Program is to create an effective system of medical support and medical supervision for those who participate in pole sport.

Main objectives:

- assist in professional development of specialists in sports medicine;
- utilize modern means of diagnostics, treatment and rehabilitation of people engaged in sports.

5) Information provision

The purpose of this section of the program is to improve the awareness of athletes and those involved in pole sport.

Main objectives:

- utilize mass media with the purpose of promoting a healthy lifestyle and attract the population to engage in regular sports events;
- provide information about new translational research;
- generalize and distribute domestic and foreign experience of methodological work;

6) Republican activity

The purpose of the program section is to actively participate in national sports activities;

Main objectives:

- participate in the work of the Federation;
- ensure the participation of national teams of Ukrainian National competitions;
- exchange experience with sports organizations in Ukraine and foreign organizations;
- cooperate with educational, scientific and information centers of the country.

4. ANALYSIS OF THE STATE AND PROSPECTS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AERIAL SPORT

4.1. Analysis of the state of pole sports in the world

The dynamics observed in recent years of increasing the number of participating teams in pole sports is indicative of the systematic work of the Federation aimed at the National development of this sport.

Among the factors that influence the development of the world sport, such as pole sport, are:

- sports in general and pole sports in particular have become part of the state policy of leading sports countries (regardless of their level of economic and social development), which leads to increased motivation of athletes, sports organizations and coaches;
- increasing commercialization of pole sports;
- modern methods for training of athletes of all levels have become more accessible for use in national teams of all countries as a result of improving the skills of coaches, as well as the ability to attract leading foreign coaches;
- strengthening the role of scientific-methodological and medical-biological support, the introduction of new non-prohibited pharmaceutical substances to the system of training athletes and the possibility of achieving high results using said substances;
- increases in the effectiveness of the system for training of gifted athletes in the pre-adolescent age and, thus, subsequent increase of results of the world's strongest athletes will be associated largely with improving the system of pole sport training for children and young people.

4.2. Analysis of the state of pole sport in the Ukraine

The state of the pole sport is characterized by the following indicators:

- athletes of the pole sports are just beginning their career;
- the number and quality of international and National sports competitions is increasing, the quality of judges' work is improving, as well as the number of competitors;
- pole sport training groups are being introduced in the system of additional education, and the number of trainees is constantly increasing;
- social security on a contractual basis is being improved and financial incentives for athletes, coaches, and other professionals are being increased as well;
- it is planned to finance pole sports from the Central Government budget;
- effective interaction has been established with the legislative and executive authorities of the Ukraine, primarily with the Agency of the Ukraine for sports and physical culture, sports organizations and other sports associations;
- effective cooperation with the media has been established.

Among other factors, the state of pole sports in the country is characterized by an insufficiently developed sports infrastructure. Infrastructure development should be systematic and correspond to the main points of growth in the regions of the country.

4.3. Analysis of the state of pole sports in Nur-Sultan city

To date, pole sports in Nur-Sultan is just beginning its active development. Recently, several dance studios have been opened for classes in the field of pole sports, but, unfortunately, there are not enough studios and schools for this type of sport.

4.4. Characteristics of problems in the development of pole sports in the country, analysis of the causes of their occurrence

First of all, there are necessary problems that affect the development of pole sports in Ukraine and require urgent solutions:

- there are not enough schools and dance studios in the country that are suitable for pole sports;
- there is an inactive implementation of scientific developments in practice;
- there is a lack of incentive legislation for sponsors to find extra-budgetary sources of funding;
- there is a lack of qualified specialists.

4.5. Justification of the need to solve development problems, analysis of various options and description of possible risks of the solution

To solve acknowledged problems, the following measures are necessary:

- availability of schools equipped with modern sports gear and equipment;
- prioritized improvement of the system of pole sport for children and young people;
- formation of interest in a healthy lifestyle among the major part of young people;
- growth in the number of athletes who have an incentive and opportunities for improvement in sports;
- development and widespread implementation of the selection and orientation system;
- advanced training and pay increase for coaches-teachers and specialists in the field of gymnastics, in particular, pole sports;
- promotion of professional benefits and prestige of pole sports and its place in world sports among young people;
- development and implementation of a system of insurance for equilibrists in case of disability;
- improving the system of social support for athletes;
- development and implementation of innovative sports technologies and corresponding growth of financial investments.

The financial risk of implementing the development program is a slowdown in the planned pace of development due to a decrease in revenue from various sources of financing.

One way to limit financial risk is to adjust program activities annually, depending on the results achieved.

Administrative risk is associated with poor management of the development program, which may lead to failure to meet the tasks and objectives of the development program due to following reasons:

- disruption of activities and failure to achieve set objectives;
- inefficient use of resources;
- increasing the probability of uncontrolled influence of negative factors on the implementation of the development program.
- One way to limit administrative risk is:

- strengthening control over the implementation of program activities;
- improvement of the current management mechanism for the implementation of the development program, timely adjustment of measures.

5. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM

The purpose of the development program is to create conditions for the development of pole sport in the Ukraine, development of sports for children and young people, promotion of pole sports as a national sport as well as the introduction of various population groups to the pole sport.

5.1. Material and technical support

Activities of the 1st stage (2024-2025) include:

- promotion of inclusion of pole sports in the list of accredited sports of the Ukraine ;
- assistance in opening new sports schools and dance studios for pole sports on the territory of the Ukraine;
- assistance to state programs for the construction and strengthening of the material foundation of sports for children and young people;
- providing members of the national pole sport teams of Ukraine with equipment necessary for competitions.

Activities of the 2nd stage (2026-2027) include:

- further support of all national and regional programs for the development of the pole sport;
- providing members of the national pole sport teams of Ukraine with sport outfit.

5.2. High-performance sport.

The purpose of this section of the development program is to create conditions for the successful performance of members of national teams of Ukraine at official National and international competitions.

Activities of the 1st stage (2024-2025) include:

- establishment of the material and technical foundation for pole sport;
- training of the reserve and regular national team of Ukraine;
- improving the level of scientific and methodological and medical and biological support for athletes and coaches;
- improving the calendar of sporting events;
- development and implementation of a system for selecting children for pole sport training;
- improving the mechanism for managing, organizing, and conducting sports events.
- development of a comprehensive program of training of Ukrainian athletes for national pole sport competitions.

Activities of the 2nd stage (2026-2027) include:

- development of the material and technical foundation for pole sport activities;
- training of the reserve and regular national team of Ukraine;

- introduction of advanced scientific, methodological, biological and medical technologies aimed at improving the content and structure of the training process;
- improving the calendar of sporting events;
- improving the system for selecting children for pole sport training;
- organization and hosting of sports events;
- development of a comprehensive program of training of Ukrainians athletes for national pole sport competitions.

5.3. Training of sports reserves

The central section of the program is aimed at creating the conditions for the selection and training of gifted children, adolescents, and youth for the national teams of Ukraine.

Activities of the 1st stage (2024-2025) include:

- improving the calendar of sporting events;
- establishment of a system for the development of the pole sport for children and young people and training of sports reserves;
- implementation of a system for selecting talented athletes and stimulating the teaching staff;
- establishment of a regional sports training center (sports reserve);
- establishment of sports schools for pole sport.

Activities of the 2nd stage (2026-2027) include:

- improving the calendar of sporting events;
- improvement of the system for the development of the pole sport for children and young people and training of sports reserves;
- improvement of the system for selecting talented athletes and stimulating the teaching staff;
- establishment of a republican sports training center (sports reserve);
- establishment of sports schools for pole sport.

5.4. Countermeasures against the use of performance-enhancing drugs and (or) banned methods in sports.

The development program is impossible without countermeasures against banned methods and drugs at all stages of sports training.

- promotion and implementation of the state anti-doping program;
- improving the effectiveness of the countermeasures against doping;
- development and implementation of anti-doping rules;
- conducting outreach and awareness-raising activities on the prevention of doping in pole sport;
- assistance in organizing of doping tests, both in-competition and out-of-competition doping control;
- improving the effectiveness of the countermeasures against doping;

5.5. The national development of pole sport, increasing mass participation, hosting physical training activities.

The purpose of sports and recreation activities in the community is to attract the population to engage in pole sport in organized forms.

Activities of the 1st stage (2024-2025) include:

- development and implementation of a set of measures to improve the status of the Republican Public Association "Ukrainian Pole Sport and Aerial Acrobatics Federation";
- expansion of functional relations and authorities with organs of various levels in the Ukraine and Kharkov city;
- assistance in establishment of sports schools for pole sport.
- development and implementation of system for sporting and mass participation events;
- support for the implementation of projects in the media.

Activities of the 2nd stage (2025-2026) include:

- systematic approach to the strengthening of the status of the Republican Public Association "Ukrainian Pole Sport and Aerial Acrobatics Federation";
- improvement of the quality of functional relations and authorities with organs of various levels in the Ukraine;
- consolidation of the system of sporting and mass participation events;
- support for the implementation of projects in the media.

5.6. Staffing

The purpose of the section of the development program is to improve the knowledge and skills of the coaching staff and provide the system of conducting pole sport competitions with qualified personnel.

Activities of the 1st stage (2024-2027) include:

- implementation of a system of continuous training and certification of coaching and teaching staff in pole sport;
- development and implementation of a set of measures to promote financial incentives for coaching and teaching staff in the pole sport;
- development and implementation of the professional development program for sports referees in pole sports;
- assistance in providing Ukrainian's leading athletes with qualified managers;
- development and implementation of a system for attracting volunteers to improve staffing during competitions;
